Help our Veterans and get a Tax Credit. An easy thing to do and doesn't cost you a thing!

What does this mean to you? You can now (FY2024) direct up to \$470, as a Head of Household or \$938 married filing jointly, of your tax obligation to the state of AZ directly to JAVC. This keeps your hard earned tax dollars in Mohave county and benefits struggling military veterans and their families. It's easy to make this donation and the best part is that it really does not cost you a cent. This credit is available state wide, not just to Mohave County residents. This credit is valid for future years, so you can donate every year that you have a tax obligation to the state of AZ.



Under the Arizona Tax Credits: Also known as the Credit for Donations made to Qualifying Charitable Organizations, households have the opportunity to reduce their direct tax liability by \$938 for couples or \$470 for an individual, when they give back to qualifying non-profits in the community.

To take full advantage of this tax credit:

1. Make checks payable to: "Jerry Ambrose Veterans Council " for the amount you wish to donate, subject to limitations.
2. Place the notation "Form 321 Tax Credit" on your check.
3. Mail your check / charitable contribution to: **JAVC, PO Box 4463, Kingman, AZ 86402** We will send you a receipt.
4. You can also donate online: www.javc.org
5. Fill out Form 321 and file it with your AZ State Tax return.



Important Notes: If you already gave a tax credit to a school, you can also give a tax credit to a Qualifying Charitable Organization. The Form 321 will be available after January 1 at www.azdor.gov under "Forms".
